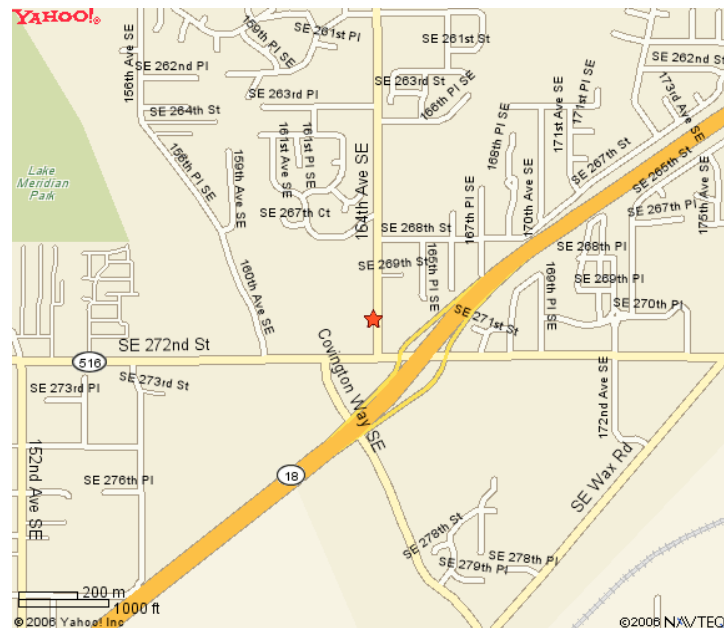


## Relationship Development Assessment<sup>®</sup> – What you can expect.....

Unless arranged otherwise, all RDA's will be conducted at the office of Carrie Sheppard, M.Ed., RDI<sup>®</sup> Program Certified Consultant. Her office is conveniently located at 27023 164<sup>th</sup> Ave SE, Suite 109 in Covington, Washington. A portion of the assessment and some follow up sessions may take place in your home, by arrangement.



- **RDA-1:** The RDA1 is the first assessment with the parent(s) and child. You and your child will be guided by your consultant through a series of enjoyable tasks. This phase of the assessment will take approximately 2 hours to complete.
- **RDA-2:** The RDA2 will be a session for the RDI<sup>®</sup> Program Certified Consultant and your child and will take approximately 1 hour. This portion of the assessment allows the RDI<sup>®</sup> Program Certified Consultant to determine the most beneficial adaptations and strategies for your child.
- **RDA-3:** The RDA3 is an interactive session for you and your child with the RDI<sup>®</sup> Program Certified Consultant. During this session you will receive hands on consultation for implementing supportive adaptations and strategies for an RDI<sup>®</sup> program developed specifically to meet the needs of your child. This session will require 1\_ - 2 hours.
- **Feedback Session:** This stage of the RDA is a parent(s) only meeting with the RDI<sup>®</sup> Program Certified Consultant. This session will provide you with a comprehensive summary of the results of the RDA; specific goals related to your child's developmental level, beneficial adaptations and strategies; strategies for addressing obstacles; and specific tools for implementation of your customized RDI<sup>®</sup> program. Please allow 1\_ to 2 hours for this meeting.
- **Home Visit/Additional Practice Session:** This is the final session of the RDA, and may be a combined session of parent-child interaction and parent(s) only discussion. Please allow up to 2 hours for this meeting.
